2023 BLAUFRÄNKISCH



Old Mission Peninsula

We began experimenting with the Austrian grape
Blaufränkisch in 2000 on a single acre vineyard on Old
Mission Peninsula. The 2023 is a blend of two subsequently
planted Old Mission Vineyards, Swanson and Keenan.

We aged this wine for eight months in traditional French Oak barrels as well as in new 300 gallon stück barrels crafted for us by French cooperage Tonnellerie de Mercurey.

This vintage is elegant with high floral and spice aromas. The alcohol is slightly lower than previous vintages, and the wine is more medium bodied. This is a refined example of a rustic grape. It's like cleaning up a rock star - you can cut the hair but you can never fully tame the wild hare.
