# 50% Pinot Blanc, 50% Auxerrois

Every Thursday a spontaneous council of growers, wine club members, and the curious gather at Left Foot Charley. As the wine flows and the yarns spin, they all become winemakers and begin blending bottles to discover new possibilities. This blend is a toast to their inventive spirit and congenial inspiration.

Auxerrois is often blended with Pinot Blanc in other wine regions, particularly in France. The softer, more supple Auxerrois tames the acidity we find in our northern Michigan Pinot Blanc, and rounds out the edges. This wine saw no oak: it was aged exclusively in stainless steel.
