Left Foot Charley has made five vintages of Red Drive over the years, and each has been unique. This year we've added a grape new to us, Saperavi, which is a varietal native to the country of Georgia. Saperavi carries a punchy fruit quality with strong acid, color, and tannin. The Blaufränkisch adds distinctive spicy black pepper. The Dornfelder lends softness and roundness to balance the wine.

The three individual varieties were aged in 1200 liter French Oak stücks (or, in French, round foudre) and traditional barrique barrels for 12 months. Once blended, the wine was aged for another three months in stainless. The wine is a medium bodied, cerebral blend of oak, fruit, and earth.
